

NSW Proof Of Identity



- At **commencement of the course**, identification documents are required.
- Identification you show us must be **original** and have your **signature and current residential Australian address**.
- Only certain identification documents can be accepted. Identification on your phone cannot be accepted.

Identification For Young Adults

Young adult licence applicants must also be accompanied by a biological parent who is named on their birth certificate.

All applicants between the ages of 12 and 16 years are required to have their parent present at the **commencement** of the course, also with ID, to sign the student declaration on the licence application. This is done at commencement of the course; it cannot be done midway through or after the course.

If an applicant does not have the ability to get a parent to sign them in at commencement of the course, please contact us for assistance with rescheduling. Grandparents, siblings, uncles, aunties, stepparents or any other family members or friends are not able to sign the student declaration. It needs to be the birth parent of the child.

Overseas Identification

All identification you give us must be from the Australian government. If you have any identification that is not from Australia, check the full list of acceptable identification.

Attending Without Correct Identification

If you don't have the correct identification, you have two options:

- Stay and do the course, absorb the knowledge. You can't do the exam on this occasion without proper identification.
- Leave and rebook another course once you have the correct identification. To do this, simply call the office on (02) 9524 5678.
